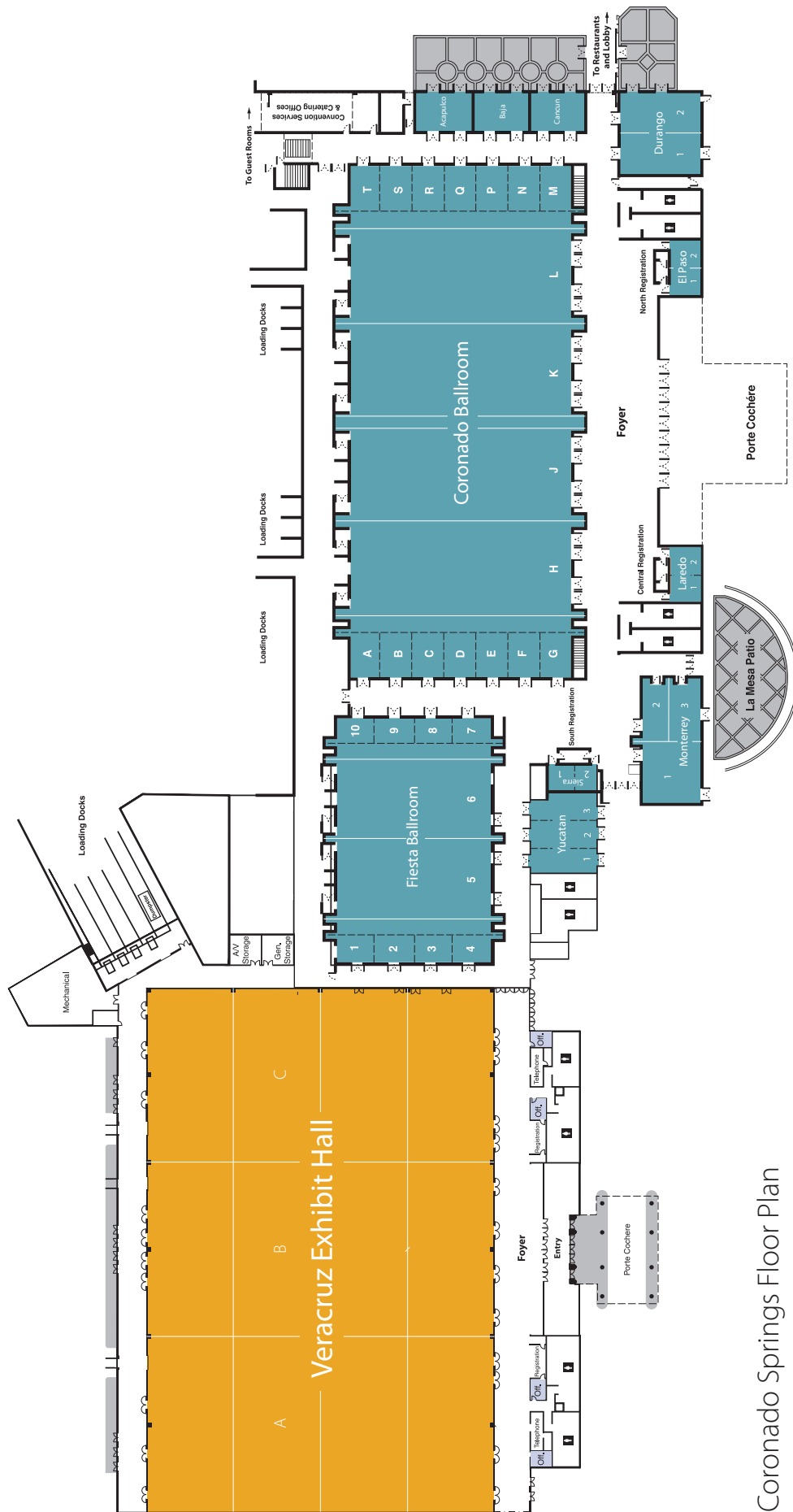


# Map of the Convention Center
